HOUSE BILL 3

Including:

Economic Development Incentives: These incentive programs would have encouraged job growth through new and existing companies, kept businesses in the state, and promoted small business development, allowing the state to be a more competitive place to do business.

Transpark Wage Assessment Incentives: Allow the termination date for a local development area to be extended beyond the original 20 year time period if existing bonds are refunded and new increment bonds are issued, for a period not to exceed 20 years from the issuance of the new bonds.

Bowling Green Downtown Signature TIF: Allow the Kentucky Economic Development Authority to reduce the minimum required capital investment for certain Signature Projects for which an agreement was entered into prior to November 1, 2007 from \$200,000,000 to \$150,000,000.
